Standards of Behaviour expected: All members of the BrosnaCan Academy community are expected to:

show self-discipline and support others.

have good manners and be polite.

display positive attitudes to school and work which emphasises high standards.

Occasionally, parents need to be more directly involved and we believe that by working closely with pupils and parents we can achieve positive results.

BrosnaCan Academy staff are responsible for modelling good behaviour and having high expectations of all children with regard to their behaviour. The studio environment gives clear messages to the children about the extent to which they and their efforts are valued.

Resources should be arranged to promote independent learning and minimise disruption.

Displays should help develop self-esteem through demonstrating the value of every individual's contribution.

Praise should be used to encourage good behaviour as well as good work.
